How do people prepare for special celebrations?

English (Writing):

Narrative

Children will write the Christmas story with a modern twist, based on our Advent nativity play, Shine.

Revise how to use dialogue to introduce characters and move action forward and figurative language to enhance descriptions.

Publish the final piece as 'White Gold' writing to be displayed outside classrooms.

R.E. (Includes other Faiths):
