The Epiphany, usually celebrated on 6<sup>th</sup> January, is a celebration of the gift of Christ to all. It is the day that the three kings visited Jesus in Bethlehem, after following a bright star, and presented their gifts to the baby Jesus of gold (to symbolise his royal birth), frankincense (to represent his divine birth) and myrrh (to recognise his mortality). The word Epiphany comes from the Greek, meaning "manifestation or to reveal", in this case the manifestation of Christ to the Magi (Three Kings) and a time now for us to thank our loving God for sending us our saviour, Jesus Christ.

## Christmas Fayre - Safety update
