ONLINE SAFETY OPENMORNING - SAVETHEDATE

As you already know, children are younger in using devices and wanting their own phones etc. We have dealt with a huge increase in online issues between our children since Christmas and together we must stay ahead of our children to keep themsafe. Our staff keep up to date with new safeguarding and computing information and we urgently need to share our knowledge with you. Research shows that the apps and games many adults think are harmless, are actually extremely harmful and not what we think. It is Safer Internet Day soon and ask that if you cannot attend all our events, this is the one you prioritise. All parents and carers are invited into school on Tuesday 6th February, 9am – 10am where you can enjoy learning in class with your child and also have refreshments in the hall whilst listening to our staff sharing their online safety advice. We know the Diocese have sent information to parishes informing them of safeguarding updates and we welcome parishioners to join this event in school to find out more about all the work we are doing in school to help safeguard our children online.
