
How do people and our planet work together?

worms!









We continued to learn about the ways that we can be Planet Protectors!

As part of our Communication and Language learning, we learnt how to use our 5 senses to describe a range of materials.




Io teach our school community how to be planet protectors, we created beautiful posters to display! We used our phonic's knowledge to write captions linked to the pictures we drew.
