

We are really proud of our improvements in attendance and punctuality and thank all parents and carers who have worked with the Attendance Team to improve attendance and punctuality. Our school has been recognised and we have been asked to share our best practice with Sheffield Schools in September! Although we have made improvements, there is still work to do to improve persistent absenteeism, reduce holidays in term time and to ensure all children are consistently on time every day. Please note that holiday fines are increasing to £80 per child per parent/carer for holidays in term time and it remains a National agenda across all schools everywhere.

We understand families wanting to book more affordable holidays therefore we have organised our term dates and INSET days next year to enabling you to book cheaper holidays in July as we break up on Friday 18th July 2025, a week earlier than most schools nationally. Also, our Easter holiday pattern is different to usual, hopefully enabling you to book a cheaper holiday in April, from Saturday 29th March to Sunday 13th April.
