Parent and Carer Survey Feedback – Thank you to all who completed the questionnaires 100% of parents say their children are happy at St Alban's

94% say their children feel safe (6% didn't know) 94% say school make sure children are well behaved (6% didn't know)

97% said any bullying has been dealt with quickly and effectively

87% say school make them aware of what their child will learn throughout the year

97% say concerns they have raised have been dealt with properly

100% of parents of children who have SEND say school gives their child the support they need 91% said school has high expectations for their child (9% said they didn't know)

91% say their children do well at St Alban's (9% say they don't know)

88% said school tell them how well their children are doing (6% said they were not sure)
84% say there are a good range of subjects on

offer at St Alban's (16% say they don't know) 94% said there are clubs and activities for their child
