WRAPAROUND CLUBS – NURSERY 3 year olds to Y6 children WELCOME!

Wrap around provision will remain at ± 4.00 for children in Reception to Y6 and ± 4.70 for 3 and 4 year olds in Nursery for the Rise and Shine session 7.45 – 8.45am.

After School Club will be charged at £4.00 up to 4.25pm or £8.00 up to 5.45pm. Arrangements in place this year will remain the same for next school year however due to funding coming to an end next year, we will not be able to waiver any late booking and late arrival/collection fees. £4.00 admin charges for late booking/arrival/collection will be charged for each occasion on a weekly basis.
