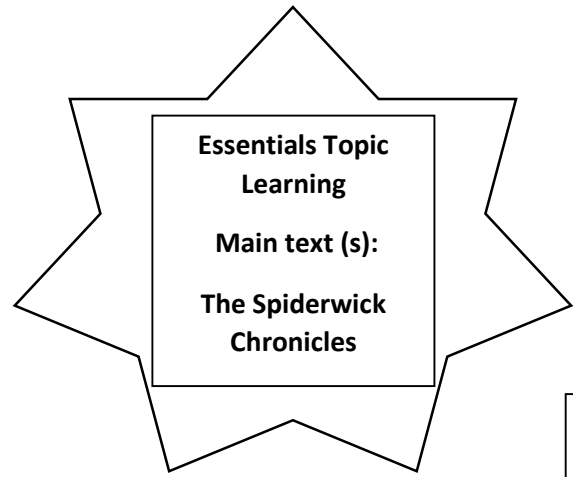
Accurate measuring when making pulleys and gears.
