### EXCELLENT OUTCOMES ONCE AGAIN!

The results of the national Multiplication Tables Check which our Y5s completed in June have been released and the national average % of children achieving full marks in the test which is timed and taken by the children online in test conditions, is 25%. We are proud to say the St Alban's % of children achieving full marks is 70%!!!! The average score nationally was 19.5 and our children's average score was 22.5. ### **ATTENDANCE**

We celebrate children with 100% attendance each week and classes with attendance higher than our 96% target. Fountains Class are highest with 95.4% attendance so far albeit still not on target. Unfortunately, our whole school attendance is below our target at 92.8% which is now below national average. Please work with us to improve your child's attendance – it is imperative they come to school on time every day. Our learning days are busy and start immediately as children arrive in the classroom and continue at pace until the bell rings at the end of the day. Don't let your child miss out on what they are entitled to.

## UNIFORM, PE KIT and JEWELLRY

Please ensure your child is dressed in correct uniform (grey trousers and dresses/skirts NOT black) as well as having correct PE kit on PE days. Only book bags are needed daily but on PE days, children can bring their kit in a bag.

Children should not wear any jewellery on PE days nor should they have ears pierced during term time if they cannot be removed. Hair-cuts must not be extreme and long hair must be tied up for health and safety.
